Bon Air United Methodist Scholarship Fund 2026

The Bon Air United Methodist Scholarship Fund was established by the generous contributions of the congregation. Scholarships will be awarded annually and the following priorities will be considered with each application.

- Membership at BAUMC
- Full Time student with a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- United Methodist Seminary Student (anywhere)
- Student at a United Methodist College in Virginia
- Those pursuing a nursing degree
- Those who have NOT received scholarships from this fund previously
- If amounts are still available, scholarships can be awarded to the same recipient no more than four times in all

Applications will be accepted in the office between May 10th and May 31st of this year and reviewed by the Scholarship Committee no later than July 31st, 2026. All Applications will be considered equally regardless of age, race, or gender.
